Show us your favorite images that capture why you love Maine – from the beauty of Maine's landscape to unique Maine people, activities and experiences – and help us celebrate our state's 200th birthday.

Submissions are being accepted February 1-18, 2020.

Guidelines for Submission to Topsham Public Library's Maine Bicentennial exhibit are as follows:

- You may submit up to three photos. Photos may be landscape or wildlife images, photos of people engaged in activities related to Maine experiences, or of favorite places - any photo that captures why you love Maine.
- Selection of images to be included in the display are at the sole discretion of the Topsham Public Library bicentennial exhibit committee. You will be contacted if your submission is to be included in the exhibit.
- Photos must be submitted digitally via our online form found on the website in a high a resolution, JPG format, 1-3 MB file size. Selected photos will be printed in a 8x10" size or larger.
- Include your name and contact information (email, phone number, address).
- Include locations where photos were taken.
- Captions and interesting information about the photos are encouraged.
- By submitting photos for the purposes stated here, you thereby state that you are the photographer and hold all legal rights to the photo and grant The Topsham Library a limited license to print and display your images for this event and the marketing of this event.
- You, not Topsham Public Library or any member of the staff, shall be responsible for any claims, legal or otherwise, made in regards to photos you submit as your own.

The exhibit will run from **February 24 – March 26, 2020** in the Crooker Gallery and Highlands Community Room at the Topsham Public Library.
